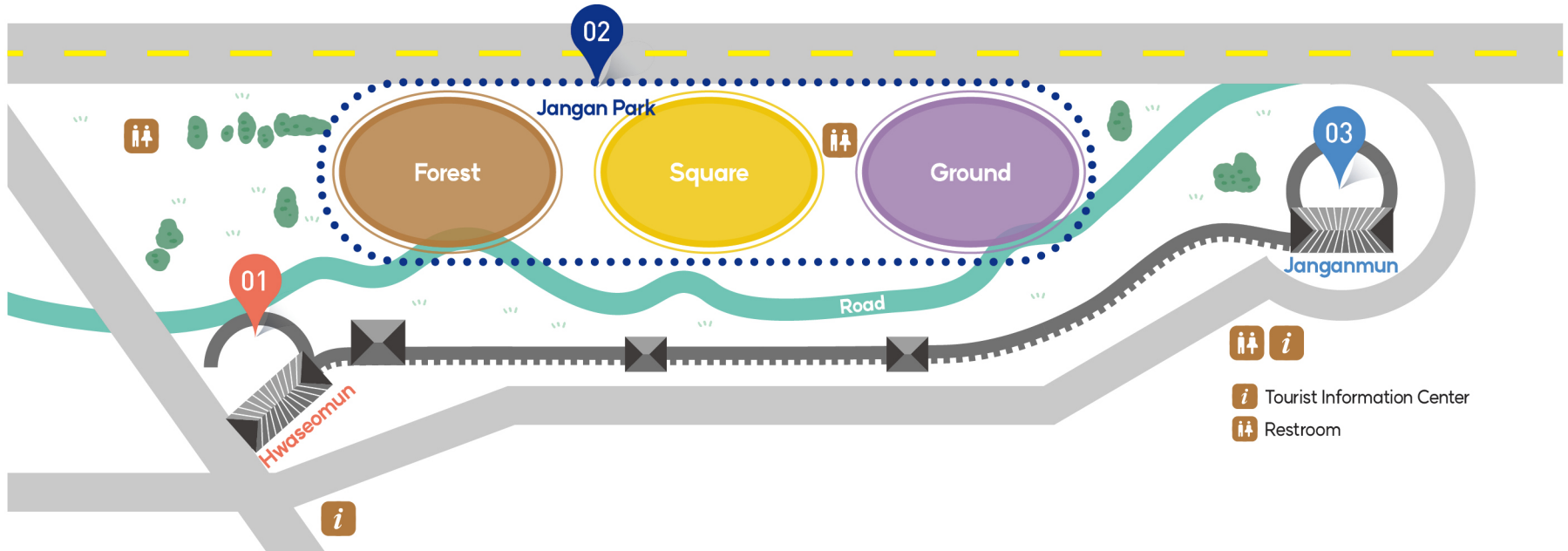

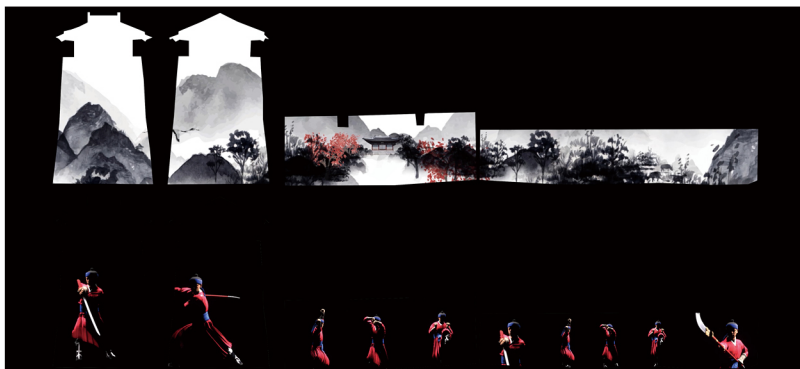
03 Media Art Janganmun Harmony Cosmos

Harmony High



"Harmony High," touching upon the festival's main theme of harmony and happiness through the Hwaseonghaenghaengdo folding screen, highlights King Jeongjo's compassion for the people and pursuit of reform and remind people of the brilliance of Suwon. This work signifies that the spirit and vision of King Jeongjo have been passed down like ten thousand large moons. With the use of anamorphic effects and split depth techniques, it presents visual illusions and fantastic images to the audience, but at the same time, intuitive images are shown to make it less abstract so that it can be enjoyed by everyone.

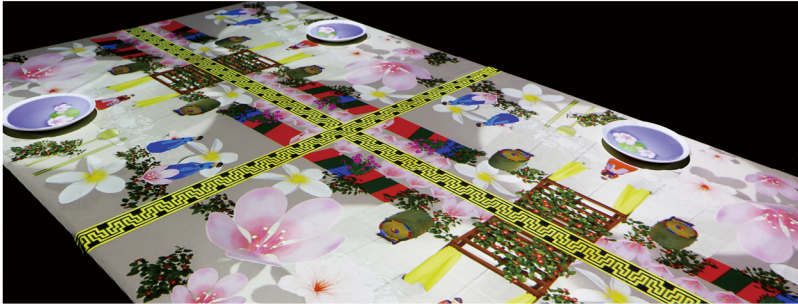

The Invitation of Queen's Party (Table Mapping)

Artist Jung Hae-jung



This work is based on Jinchanyeon, the 60th birthday celebration organized by King Jeongjo for his mother, Lady Hyegyeng of the Pungsan Hong dan. It was created in the form of table mapping, which involves projecting images onto a table using projection mapping technology. The video created with 3D and AI motion capture technology while referring to historical documents shows a suksu, referring to a male royal court chef in the Joseon Dynasty, cooking and court ladies in hanbok in gorgeous colors serving food and dancing for the guests. The images of the witty and lively movements of the suksu and the court ladies and the fine royal court desserts (byeonggwa) prepared for Lady Hyegyeng's birthday will delight your eyes.

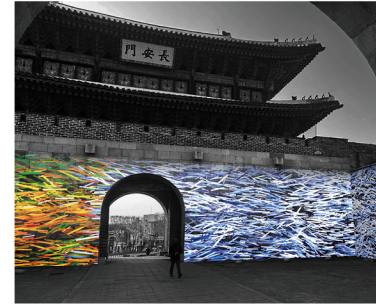

The Accumulation of Countless Times

The work originated from a personal interpretation of cosmos, an infinite space that has expanded over time in terms of physical space and is continuing to be fluid even now. It was thought that within a space, relationships are formed by whatever is in it, according to rules amid disorder, and that these relationships take the form of cycles and appear in different forms. The movements and appearances of these relationships bloom countless times over time, which is depicted in this work.

Harmony

This is a media façade embodying the harmony of all things in the universe, with nature and humans coming together to move from the past to the present and into the future. The video starts with a feast of flowers, symbolizing the rebirth of nature, moves on to an infinite space where living things float in the motif of dancheong (traditional multicolored paintwork on wooden buildings) inside the Jangnamun, and ends with the motif of mother-of-pearl crafts. The last scene, in particular, presents a nightscape of Suwon, centered on the Jangnamun, and shows Suwon moving from the past to the present and into the future through the brilliant light reflecting off of mother-of-pearl.

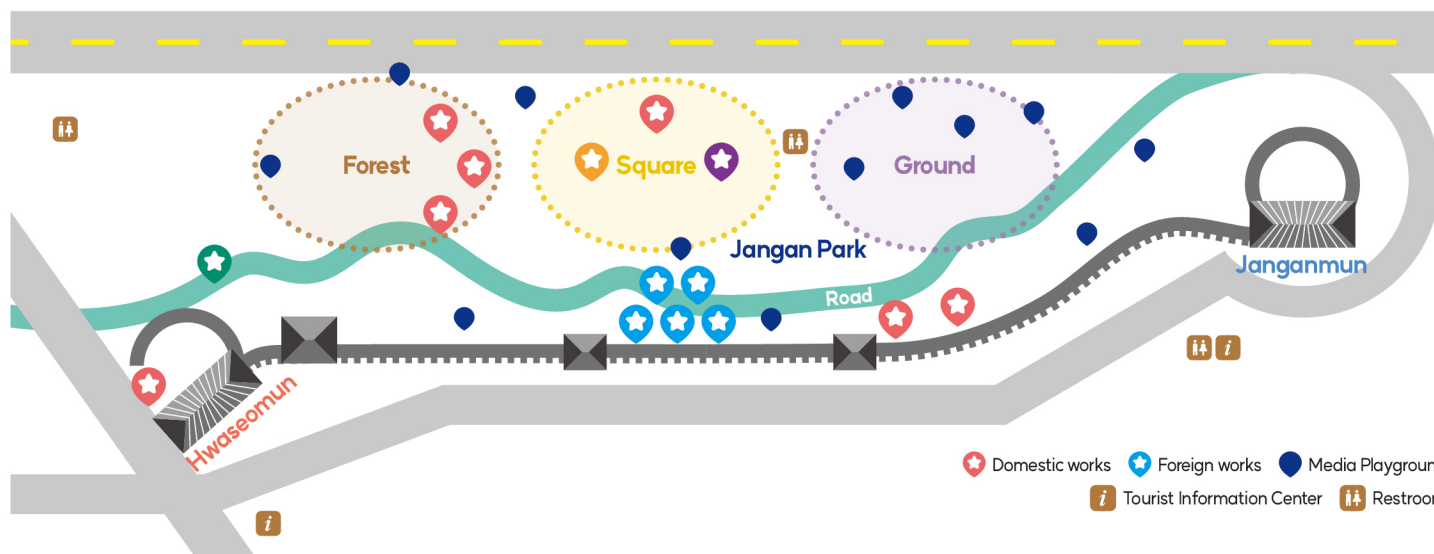

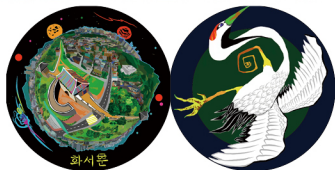

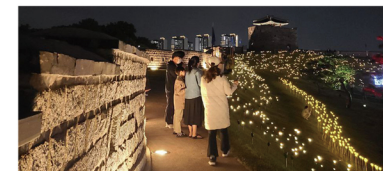

Light patterns created through lasers and the media art sculpture stimulate the visual and auditory senses using various types of media and technology.

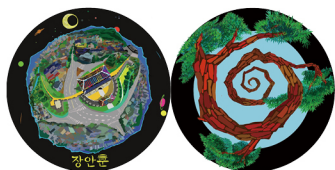

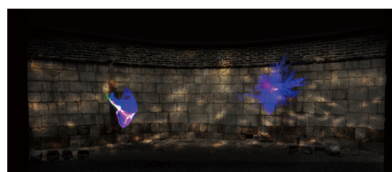

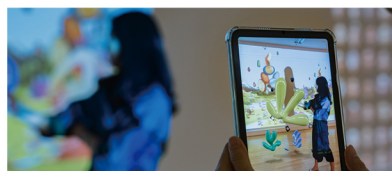
